

Gretna Glen Camp & Retreat Center Day Guests-Covid-19 Guidelines

The guidelines below are precautions that we are taking to reduce the risks related to COVID-19. These guidelines are based on ACA, CDC, and State Recommendations.

We cannot guarantee that COVID-19 will not enter camp. It is the responsibility of the guest group leader to communicate and enforce the guidelines below.

- If you are sick or around someone who has been sick or a known exposure to someone with COVID-19, please do not come to camp. Please also check your temperature prior to attending anything at Gretna Glen. Temp should be below 100.4. Gretna Glen may ask you to leave site if you appear sick.
- You must wash your hands before and after participating in activities at Gretna Glen. Also after using the restroom and before eating. We have added additional handwashing and hand sanitizer stations around camp.
- Physical distancing of six feet & use of masks is the best practice to stay safe. Please keep this in mind when around those that are not in your household.
- Due to COVID-19 we are not able to open all the spaces/buildings at camp. Please follow the directions provided for the event you are attending in knowing what is available for your use.
- Gretna Glen staff will be wearing masks when providing program or food service for you. There may be times that we require you to wear a mask depending on the activity that you are participating in. If social distancing is not possible, a mask is a must. We will advise you of this in advance.
- Gretna Glen will clean and sanitize spaces daily. We are limiting use of indoor spaces.
