- Follow all rules that are presented to me to the best of my ability.
- Actively participate in all events when physically able.
- Stay with my group at all times unless given other instructions.
- Let my counselors know if I have a problem, concern, or feel homesick.
- Care for myself by being quiet and resting during Rollover and after lights out.
- Take responsibility for my actions and accept the consequences of my behavior.
- Seek the good and the positive in everything.
